What is ANEC?

Association Nationale **Etudes et Chantiers** (National Association Etudes et Chantiers)

Etudes et Chantiers was created in 1962 by several Youth movements following the idea of non-violence and humanism as well as international co-operation and exchanges in the “Education Populaire” movement – a French concept meaning non formal education. We are engaged in the world-wide movement of international voluntary services (short term and long term) through partnerships with around 130 organisations in more than 70 countries.

Our National Association is composed by 5 regional associations, with an international placement office in Clermont-Ferrand:

- **ECC** : Etudes et Chantiers Corsica
- **ECEnCi** : Etudes et Chantiers Engagement Civique – East part of France
- **ECIDF** : Etudes et Chantiers Ile de France – Paris area and North of France
- **ECMP** : Etudes et Chantiers Midi-Pyrénées – South West part of France
- **CACIAURA** : CHANTIERS ACTIONS CITOYENNETE et INCLUSION AURA, projet Etudes et Chantiers – Centre and South-East of France and the International Delegation.

Each regional organisation runs permanent projects independently from each other, but they work together on the workcamp programme which is co-ordinated at the National and International level by the International Delegation in Clermont-Ferrand.

We organise around 25 international camps every year:

- Camps for minors between 14-17 years old,
- Camps for +18 years old, most of them with no upper age limit.

Another large part of our activities is to develop activities with people facing social or economical difficulties. Our regional organisations manage several local inclusion work projects with youth or adults facing exclusion. This is the larger part of our action that involves us in the employment or social public schemes and in European programmes.

TEENAGE WORKCAMPS 2020

Since 1962, Etudes et Chantiers - ANEC has been organising workcamps for minors between 14-17 years olds and sometimes between 11-13 years old. They are organised following the “Minor’s Protection Act” under the control of Youth and Sports Ministry. These rules facilitate the organisation of workcamps and the security of the volunteers.

Volunteers achieve a concrete project; they work about **25 hours** per week.

The leader team is composed, according to the French law, of 3, 4 people (for workcamps of 20 teenagers) who are qualified in leading; they are paid staff and they are responsible for the volunteers. Teenagers are taken in charge on their arrival at the train station; they cannot leave the camp without an authorisation signed by the parents and sent to our organisation.

Each volunteer must send a “**health form**” with the **confirmation** of arrival **at least 15 days before the camp starts**.

Camp languages are English and French in every project.

On each camp for minors, we open between 1 and 4 places for **youth facing social** (like living in orphanages or in specialized institutions). Be aware that these volunteers expect a lot from a workcamp experience; it is a big adventure for them and good contacts with International volunteers are really important.

Insurance: our organisation covers the volunteers from the first to the last day of the project for **third risk, individual accident, repatriation. Our insurance does not cover lost or stolen objects, nor illness** (except those due to accidents, during the workcamp).

Volunteers from the E.U. countries MUST bring a European Health card to cover their cost (medical, pharmaceutical and hospitalisation cover).

For all our teenage workcamps international volunteers must pay **extra-fees (250 €) before going to the project by bank transfer or by cash at the arrival to the leader**. The extra fees cover a part of the camp leaders’ salaries and costs.

- If an international volunteer withdraws from a project less than 30 days before its start, the participation fee (250 €) is not refunded.
- If an international volunteer withdraws from a project less than 30 days before it starts and the volunteer has not paid their participation fee, they will be asked to do so.
- If an international volunteer withdraws from a project less than 30 days before its start and the volunteer has not paid its participation fee, Etudes et Chantiers International (ANEC) can ask the sending partner for payment of this sum (250 €).

Description of the partner organizing/hosting the project :	<p>Inside a lovely little French village, the castle of Montaigu le Blin is an impressive medieval fortress, classified as Historical Monument. It is located on the top of a hill, overlooking the countryside. Since 2002, volunteers have been participating, every summer, to the restoration of the castle. These last years, the fortress has regained its beauty! In 2019, the volunteers started to restore the masonry of the Chambers of Lords and created a medieval vegetable garden at the foot of the tower. This year, it's your turn to live an experience back in time!</p>	
Description of work :	<p>Participate to the protection and enhancement of this breathtaking heritage! Within the castle, you will realize various works of restoration of walls (ramparts, towers) using traditional techniques and help maintain the vegetation (clearing bushes, etc.) as well as many other varied tasks. Beyond this work, you will reflect together on sustainable development using traditional techniques in the restoration of the fortress, but also in the daily life of the group. Campleaders will guide you along the project. You will also take part in the tourist activities of the site by welcoming the visitors (tourists and local inhabitants) in the castle and explain the work, show the progress you have been doing the last few weeks! Protecting this piece of heritage takes time, and a lot of energy. Come and contribute to its rebuilding!</p>	
Description of accomodation and food :	<p>Accommodation is under tents (2 people per tent) at the town stadium lent by the Town Hall. Tents will be provided. You will have to bring other camping material (ground sheet, sleeping bag, etc.). You, volunteer, are actor/actress of your project! You will manage the tasks of daily life in teams (shopping, cooking, and cleaning). A rotation will be organised by the campleaders to ensure the smooth running of daily life. The objective is to gain autonomy and that everyone acts individually to allow a good collective functioning! All together, you will think about how to work, feed everyone, have fun, get around, visit the region in the most environmentalaly and human-friendly way. A building on the field includes a kitchen room, 2 showers and 2 toilets for the group.</p>	
Description of location and leisure:	<p>Montaigu le Blin is located in the French Bourbonnais area, 30km North from Vichy and 90km North from Clermont-Ferrand, in the French Auvergne region. It is a countryside rich with historical heritage, which you will be able to discover by visiting a few of the numerous castles and medieval cities, by hiking, going by bike or canoeing, according to what the leading team and the weather can propose. The inhabitants of the village are used to seeing volunteers from all over the world come every summer. You will pick up bread from the innkeeper Didier, ask for eggs on a Sunday evening to Monique, the weather the next day to Jean Pascal, show your progress to Jean Louis who is passionate about the castle, you will feast with the fruits and vegetables offered by the local gardeners...and so much more! The campleaders will prepare games and activities for the group but will also encourage you to propose and build your own activities according to your desires. Bring ideas and be creative!</p>

Description of specific requirements :	<p>EXTRA FEES: reduced to 250€ for international volunteers. Pay attention! Our national participants in France pay the regular 360€ of extra fees. Description of the partner organizing/hosting the project :	<p>Are you interested into an environmental challenging experience? Come and experiment a three weeks full immersion into an eco-friendly association where you can learn how to produce your own basic products (hygiene products, food). This will be a once in a life chance to discover the nature surrounding the place and to enjoy simple life activities such as cooking pizzas in an outdoor stone oven, gardening and discover agriculture, crafts activities. You will also share all these moments with the other people of the group and make new friends!</p> <p>The association La Feina is managed by a group of people who have chosen to experience, daily, an eco-friendly way of life.</p> <p>The association and its eco-hamlet come to life by organising educational workshops: crafts, agriculture, environmental education. The association also welcomes groups and events on the land. Their activities are integrated respecting the local dynamics. The eco-hamlet is located in a beautiful rural mountainous area. The activities proposed are organised taking into consideration the surrounding environment and available resources.</p> <p>Last year (2019), two workcamps were organised in La Feina. Description of work :	<p>The workcamp's goal is to help the association to develop. You will help restore the local heritage, continue the work begun by the group of volunteers last year:</p> <p>You will help restore a typical barn in the area (inside and outside masonry work), which is designed to host cultural events to support the hamlet and the</p>	

	<p>entire territory.</p> <p>Your missions will be to remove the old joints and apply new mortar to make the barn waterproof and show its original appearance!</p> <p>Beyond this masonry work, you will be immersed in the hamlet's life. You will help maintain the site, the vegetable garden, help with the picking and harvesting. Get ready to discover a new eco-friendly life-style and bring back home tons of new good practices!</p>
<p>Description of accomodation and food :</p>	<p>You will be accomodated in tents (2 people per tent), in the eco-camping of the association. The tents will be provided. You will have to bring their camping equipment (ground sheet, sleeping bag, etc.). The campsite includes sanitary facilities (showers with solar-heated water, dry toilets) and a summer kitchen with a breathtaking view over the valley.</p> <p>You will use and do your own environmental-friendly hygiene and care products (soaps, toothpaste, laundry, etc.).</p> <p>You, volunteer, are actor/actress of your project! You will manage the tasks of daily life in teams (shopping, cooking, and cleaning). You will also have the opportunity to bake your special meals in the association's bread oven! A new experience to discover!</p> <p>A rotation will be organised by the campleaders to ensure the smooth running of daily life. The objective is to gain autonomy and that everyone acts individually to allow a good collective functioning!</p> <p>All together, you will think about how to work together, feed everyone, have fun, get around, visit the region in the most environnementaly and human-friendly way.</p>
<p>Description of location and leisure:</p>	<p>The association is a charming drop-in center, located in a hamlet where the management group and some neighbours live together and host from time to time, holiday-makers, friends and hikers.</p> <p>The hamlet is composed of a cottage, several workshops, some typical stone and wooden houses, a hut, a barn, some camping sites, a vegetable garden, an orchard...</p> <p>The eco-hamlet is situated in the medieval town of Fontanges, very rich in heritage, in a valley near the Cantal Mountains, crossed by the river Aspre. There are many walks and hikes to do. You will be able to visit the surrounding villages, discover waterfalls and observe the local fauna and flora. Close by, you will be able to visit the typical village of Salers where you can meet craftsmen and taste delicious local specialties.</p>
<p>Sustainable Development Goals identified:</p>	<p>By participating in this workcamp, you are thinking of the way you buy and eat (UN SDG 12 Responsible Consumption and Production) and combatting climate change (SDG 13 Climate Action).</p>
<p>Short remarks for the project :</p>	<p>The hamlet is located in a beautiful, rather isolated, rural valley (15 minutes by car from the nearest village, 30 minutes by car from the nearest town).</p> <p>The association does not have WiFi by choice, and the mobile network is weak. But don't worry, enjoy reconnecting with yourself, the people around you and the environment! Volunteers can access a wired internet connection and network sharing.</p> <p>Unfortunately, the site is not accessible by wheelchair.</p> <p>As you understood, sustainable development is in the heart of the project. For reasons of consistency, we encourage you to choose environmentally friendly ways to travel and avoid planes if possible.</p>

Description of the partner organizing/hosting the project :	<p>The Solidarity Garden is an inclusion project for people who are facing several social difficulties. The workcamp will be an opportunity for you to work together and take part to this human adventure. Since 2001, our organisation welcomes workers in various orchards, farm, beehives and organic vegetable gardens. Members of the organisation come each day in the solidarity garden to pick their vegetables on the advice of the volunteers and workers. We also lead actions for environmental education towards youth. The garden is like a pond between nature et cities. This year, the service of Historical Protection will guide you through time, exploring the town's evolution from the small winery village to street art. This walking tour is an original way to discover Grigny, its nature and inhabitants!</p> <p>For 10 years now, we host volunteers from all around the world for a workcamp at the Garden. They have optimised animals' shelter, decorated workers' house, created pedagogical beehives... Their implication has implemented more than we could have done on our own.</p> <p>Discover the volunteers' testimony from 2019 on our channel: https://youtu.be/C1zYsp6_Ob8!</p>	
Description of work :	<p>During two weeks, you will take part in the farm's life and help workers in their everyday organic farming's tasks, beekeeping and animal care. A part of your time will also be dedicated to set up a garden: build furnitures such as tables and benches, farming trays, or decoration made out of natural materials. The workers of pour local partner will be assisting you in all these steps. Do it yourself, simplicity and environmental learning are part of the program!</p> <p>A building will be in renovation process during the workcamp. We count on your energy to help us bring a new light on the site and welcome youth and adults in a freshly renovated beautiful place!</p>	
Description of accomodation and food :	<p>The volunteers will sleep in tents in the garden, at the House of Children and Nature, located 100m away from the work site. You will have access to a kitchen, to the bathrooms and a common room for indoor activities. Camp</p>

Description of the partner organizing/hosting the project :	In the heart of the Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes region volcanoes' chain, classified UNESCO World Heritage, volunteers have been working, for 15 years now, every summer, to restore and maintain local natural, cultural or built heritage. Our association works hand in hand with the local council of Hautes Terres Community since a few years. The objective is to organise every year a workcamp in each community of the territory to meet all the population. After spending a few years restauring the dry stone walls of Chastel-sur-Murat, this year a new village is welcoming the workcamp: La Chapelle Laurent.	
Description of work :	La Chapelle Laurent's village is very enthusiastic to welcome a workcamp for the first time! Local councilors have implemented a program of typical heritage rehabilitation, and this is where we step in: we need to help the village to restaure its washing place. A specialised company will start working on the impermeability works before the workcamp and your mission will be to embellish the surroundings by restoring the dry-stone wall which supports the	

	washing place. If the weather is good, why not go further and build benches with recycled materials to allow inhabitants to enjoy fully the place?! You will generally be working in the morning and will enjoy the afternoons visiting the region and participating to activities. The schedule will be adapted to the group's organisation in order to combine working and leisure time all together in a good mood!
Description of accomodation and food :	<p>Acommodation is under tents (2 people per tent) in the municipal stadium. Daily life is organised by volunteers (shopping, cooking, and cleaning) under a common big tent. Showers and toilets are in a building of the stadium. You, volunteer, are actor/actress of your project! You will manage the tasks of daily life in teams (shopping, cooking, and cleaning). A rotation will be organised by the campleaders to ensure the smooth running of daily life. The objective is to gain autonomy and that everyone acts individually to allow a good collective functioning!</p> <p>All together, you will think about how to work, feed everyone, have fun, get around, visit the region in the most environnementaly and human-friendly way. A kitchen is installed under a a tend, showers and toilets are in a building, 50m away from the camp.</p>
Description of location and leisure:	<p>La Chapelle Laurent's village is located in the heart of the Cantal department, nearby the Haute-Loire department, in the region of Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes. The small rural villages are full of houses with typical stone roofs and wooden/stone walls. The villages have a very rich built heritage (bread ovens, chapels, castles). This region is the perfect place to go for a hike in the mountains, by foot, by bike, for practicing canoe, to visit and admire the small streets of the village, to go swimming in the lakes, according to what the leading team and the weather can propose. The leaders will prepare games and entertainment, but you will be invited to propose and organise your own activites according to your ideas and wishes, so bring your creativity!</p>

Description of the partner organizing/hosting the project :	<p>Since 2001, volunteers participate to the historical heritage renovation and environmental protection of Aurillac, city located in the heart of the French region Auvergne. The association Etudes et Chantiers and the city council of Aurillac are partners since 2014. This partnership was established for local volunteers and workcamp volunteers to meet and share activities during summer. 4 groups of volunteers have already intervened in the community gardens of Aurillacs' social center in order to participate to its development. The volunteers have created a wooden path made out of recycled pallets to facilitate the access in the gardens, helped to build huts for the garden, built furnitures and shared pleasant moments with the gardeners. Description of work :	<p>This year, volunteers will embellish, maintain and organise the gardens guided by the camp leaders and the local gardeners. At the entrance of the shared gardens there is a conviviality space with tables and chairs. Nevertheless, no dedicated space for cooking nice dishes is available. ANEC ADULT WORKCAMP

Usually we host 12 volunteers on each of our workcamps (9, 10 international volunteers + 2, 3 French participants) but some projects are open to 8, 10 or 15 volunteers.

On our adult projects you work about **30 hours per week**; most of the time you don't work on week-ends, but it might happen for different reasons.

In our workcamps, all activities are decided together with the volunteers and the camp leaders. You will live a group experience.

The languages spoken on our workcamps are English and French, except on specific international French speaking camps (indicated in the description).

Every day life: the group will organise teams so that everybody can participate in the cleaning, tidying up, and preparation of the meals... do not forget your recipes!

Activities: on your arrival, leaders will propose several activities; but your ideas are welcome and everything can be discussed. So be imaginative, the workcamp is a place for having fun! We don't expect you to do activities on your own, going to visit friends living nearby or going alone to watch a movie!

Leading team: camp leaders are not there to manage everything; they advise volunteers, suggest various activities; they are also a link between the different actors of the workcamp: the organising association, the project sponsor, the local population and the volunteers. Our camp leaders are usually paid, but we might also have volunteer leaders.

Age Limit: 18 years old minimum –no age limit.

Sometimes, we might accept 17 year old participants in some of our adult camps if they already have had a volunteering experience and if they are mature enough to join an adult project (a motivation letter is necessary for minor volunteers). Priority goes to French Access 4 All.

On each adult project we open at least 1 or 2 places for people facing social or psychological difficulties (like living in orphanages or in specialized institutions). Be aware that these volunteers expect a lot from a workcamp experience; it is a big adventure for them and good contacts with International volunteers are really important.

Insurance: our association covers the volunteers **from the first to the last day** of the project (**third risk, individual accident, repatriation**). **Our insurance does not cover lost or stolen objects, or illness** (except those due to accidents, during the workcamp).

Volunteers from E.U. countries MUST bring a European Health Card to cover their cost (replacing the E111 form) (medical, pharmaceutical and hospitalisation cover).

No advance of money will be given to them.

Our adult camps have no extra fees.

For the fifth consecutive year, an international workcamp will take place in order to maintain the wonderful Château. 
