About us:

Lunaria is a *nonprofit association for social promotion*, secular, independent and autonomous from political parties, established in 1992.

It promotes peace, social and economic justice, equality and guarantee the rights of citizenship, democracy and grassroots participation, social inclusion and intercultural dialogue.

“We ask to the international volunteers to commit themselves in the mission of the hosting projects, having an **open mind**, and arriving aware that the accommodation conditions may not be suitable for those looking for cheap and comfortable holidays. Every project is made by many factors, and we need from the volunteers a problem-solving approach.”

The workcamp is coordinated by an experienced volunteer, who is not the boss of the camp: we ask the camp-coordinators to ease the first days of the camp and to involve the volunteers in a being responsible of the project, using consensus methodology. The camp-coordinator is not at all responsible for volunteers' fun and the best camp has a camp-coordinator who slightly go back to the status of normal volunteer.....So, prepare to take responsibilities!

Age limits: For adult camps see details in the program tables and for the TEEN camp: 16-17.

Common language used in the camps: English

Fees: Some exceptions are meant to support the costs of the project (15-25 €).

TEEN workcamps have participation fee to cover the cost of the professional leaders and part of the project costs. No administrative costs are covered by the participation fee.

Inscription fee for Italian volunteers is 105€.

Insurance: Lunaria provides insurance to all the volunteers (SCI scheme)

Agape International Ecumenical Centre is an important point of reference in Italian Protestantism, being for 70 years a place of education and development, theological exploration, political engagement, acceptance and validation of differences. A resident group still lives at Agape throughout the year. Agape was built after the Second World War as a sign of hope and reconciliation between people, thanks to the voluntary work of many young men and women. PROJECT: Every year many people, with different ages and religious, cultural and political backgrounds, come to Agape to discuss and to be challenged, to get to know themselves and each other and to exchange experiences around a particular theme. The work camp will support the management and support the meetings on issues of political, social, cultural and religious interest. The center is volunteers-driven, and its management is in your hands.

WORK: Volunteers will help in the following tasks: kitchen, meal service (tables and dishes), cleaning, maintenance, bartending, babysitting.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD: Volunteers will be host in 3-4 bed bedrooms with shared toilets on the floor. The meals are typical Italian Mediterranean cuisine, with limited consumption of meat

for environmental reasons, and the possibility of choices for those who require a special diet. There is a washing machine available for the volunteers.

LOCATION AND LEISURE: Agape is in the Alps, close to Prali commune. Games, discussions, and outings can be organized during free time. Programmed activities (especially in the evening) are most of the time open to the volunteers, as long as they do not clash with work commitments. The place is beautiful but isolated, though you will stay together with many international participants attending the meetings of Agape. **TERMINAL:** Turin

REQUIREMENTS: Volunteers should come ready to accomplish each task and with an open mind. Volunteers before arrival should contact the Agape secretariat before arriving since travel to Agape can be complicated.

SUMMARY: You are passionate by the classical theater and by the history? Join the International Festival of Classical Theater of Palazzolo Acreide and make alive again the Greek theater of Akrai the most distinguished monument in the archaeological site!

PARTNER: The festival is organized by the National Institute of Ancient Drama (known by the acronym INDA) and the workcamp is managed by a local organization called "Fare Palazzolo".

PROJECT: The International Youth Festival of Classical Theater is the most important theater event dedicated to future generations on the national and international scene. Since 1991 the performances take place in the Greek Theater of Akrai in Palazzolo, where boys and girls of all ages present very original interpretations of classical Greek and Latin texts, during an event whose strengths are participation and being together. The purpose is to support the management of the festival and the 80 schools that will participate in the festival. The volunteers of the workcamps will take care of the reception of the young actors who will play in those days. The aim is to coordinate the whole event only with a young and motivated group of people, who will have during the experience the opportunity to match with more than 1600 actors/young people from all over the world. The festival will be run from May 16 to June 7 and two turns of workcamp will be organized.

WORK: Volunteers will support the organization of the "International Festival of Classical Theater for Young People ". They will be active about 5/6 hours a day with different tasks and they will be organized daily in two rotating groups. A group will take care of the activities at the Greek Theater (reception, the work of masks in the theater and order service) while another group will take care of the activity at the Youth Hostel for the lunch organization and for the afternoon cultural activities dedicated to the actors.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD: Volunteers will go to live in a hostel with comfortable rooms. There will be a kitchen where they can cook independently. There is no canteen service but the volunteers will have to cook on their own or choose to have lunch (lunch only) with the actors who will be guests of the hostel during the camps. The food for the kitchen will be provided by us and if there are special requests we will try to satisfy them. The hostel has been recently renovated and has bathrooms and showers. We will supply sheets and blankets or other things if necessary.

LOCATION AND LEISURE: Palazzolo, UNESCO heritage site, is a quiet town of 9000 inhabitants and is located 30km from the most beautiful beaches in Sicily!

In the evening, you will have fun in the pubs and in the most visited places in the town, which is full of architectural and naturalistic beauties. There will be games and entertainment to spend the evenings with the local group ..we will not get bored! **TERMINAL:** Catania Airport, Palazzolo Acreide bus Station

PARTNER: Lunaria and Cilento Youth Union have organized several successful workcamps in the last years. Cilento Youth Union is a youth NGO started in Rofrano (SA) in 2015, targeting Italian youth with fewer opportunities from the south of Italy and specifically from the Cilento area. This workcamp is co-organized by Gazania Association, that proposes the study of the Byzantine history of Cilento and Vallo di Diano, the research and enhancement of cultural emergencies and ancient paths that can be traced back to the settlements of Italic monks. By joining this workcamp you will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals: **SustainableCommunities -SDG11.**

PROJECT: FOLLOW THE MONK! To the heart of the Cilento, Vallo of Diano and Alburni National Park is a workcamp about Bizantine heritage of Cilento and Vallo of Diano, sub-regions in Salerno province, researching and valorising cultural heritage and ancient paths linked to the settlements of Italian-Greek monks. Since 2018 the local promoters work on the realization of the “Cammino di San Nilo”. This is a route of 103 km, divided into 7 stages, crossing 10 small rural villages included in Cilento, Vallo of Diano and Alburni National Park. The aim of the project is to clean and improve the footpaths that integrate the "Cammino di San Nilo". In particular, volunteers will be asked to increase the signage along the entire route and in both directions. The volunteers will walk each stage of the “Cammino” together with a guide and will be transferred by bus from the San Mauro La Bruca headquarters to the starting point of the stage and vice versa for the return to the guest house.

WORK: The volunteers will be involved in different activities. Manual work: mow grass, repair and secure the fence, wood and stone steps, rid the path of trees and greenery obstructing the walk, fix dry small stone walls and pave paths with local natural stones, integrating signposting; Garbage collection work along the paths of “Cammino di San Nilo”; Forest work like clean undergrowth and forest floor, prune branches and plants.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD: All volunteers will be accommodated at the guest house at San Mauro La Bruca, located in the centre of the town and equipped with mattresses, toilet and kitchen, where they will prepare meals, arranged according to Mediterranean cuisine. For this reason, volunteers will be assisted by a typical Cilento inhabitant. It's recommended to bring: sunscreen, work clothes (included gloves, shoes), swimsuit but also warm clothes and K-way, sleeping bug, video-camera

LOCATION AND LEISURE TIME: San Mauro La Bruca is a town and commune in the province of Salerno, in Campania, region of south-western Italy. It's located in the middle of Cilento, the sub-region which is home of the Mediterranean Diet and rich in biodiversity. It's integrated by the hamlet of San Nazario, where the ancient abbey that housed San Nilo was located. It's situated in the hills, but not far from the Cilento coast... so don't forget to bring your swimming suit! With less than 600 inhabitants and its breath-taking panoramas, it is a very exotic and unusual place to visit. The area is rural and inner, far from urban centres, but people are very hospitable and always ready for conversation... in a very nice dialect! **TERMINAL:** Rome and Naples

SPECIFICS REQUIREMENT: open-minded, attitude to outdoor manual activities, positive artistic attitude, flexible to eat local food, ready to interact with other people of different cultural background, willing to share own experiences, flexible to live in simple living conditions.

SUMMARY: Within an international group, support the renovation of a historical park.

PARTNER: For 5 years, the association "Rise Hub" is working actively on the development of the Valle di Comino, also through the organisation of workcamps. The association "Rise Hub" was established in 2015 in Valle di Comino, a rural area composed of many small towns surrounded by mountains between the cities of Rome (120km) and Naples (180km) with an increasingly intercultural composition of the population. The association aims to create a connection between unemployed youngsters, migrants, refugees, and asylum seekers living on the

territory, with local institutions and private firms. Its members are mainly women, girls, and refugees, and it counts with several volunteers of different ages and backgrounds.

By joining this workcamp you will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals: **SustainableCommunities-SDG11.**

PROJECT: The idea of this workcamp arises from the will to bring international volunteer project closer to local young people, and to support the local community of Atina in improving the conditions of the environment of San Stefano Hill, for a long time almost abandoned but with a deeply artistic, historical and natural potential. The aim is to create a new meeting attraction amid nature and revitalize the town's hill so that inhabitants can enjoy a cleaner, renovated park, and have a common meeting place.

WORK: The park area where volunteers will work is in a state of neglect even though is the place where local youth uses to hang out the most. The first days of the workcamp will be dedicated to know the community of Atina and to prepare the area to be renovated. The volunteers will initially clean the area and repair some missing parts of stone benches in the park with different materials. The participants will cooperate to create together (natural installations, outdoor toys, pieces of furniture, information panels, etc.). When the work is completed, the project area will be cleaned. The volunteers will work 5 hours a day and they will have 2 days free.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD: The volunteers will be accommodated inside the park, in camping with services like kitchen, bathroom, showers, and a covered area with tents and mattresses. The camp is equipped with a wifi area, and it is in the center of Atina, so bars, banks, minimarkets, post offices are all nearby. Food will be vegetarian and most of the groceries will be purchased from local producers and farmers. Volunteers will be also invited to join for typical local organizations ad associations of citizens. On the first day of the workcamp, the "camp rules" will be shared with the group and expected to be followed throughout the whole duration.

LOCATION and LEISURE TIME: Atina is a small, rural Municipality of approximately 420 inhabitants, in southern Lazio (same region as the capital, Rome). Atina is said o have mythological connections with the Roman god of Saturn. Saturn is also said to have taught these native people how to build houses, to cultivate the land and plant vines and to live together harmoniously. Thus he became known as the Roman God of agriculture and fertility The main attraction of the town is the historical center and the archaeological site. Hundreds of tourists visit the town not only for his history and monuments but also for the genuine tasty food and the untouched natural beauties that the town offers. Meeting points will be arranged according to your time of arrival at Rome Airport, and therefore the time you will take the train to Cassino train station. **TERMINAL:** Rome

REQUIREMENTS: This project is supported by the European Solidarity Corps. Food and accommodation are covered by the European Union. Transportation costs will be refunded according to the distance band rules of the program. No fees are required. The workcamp is open for 8 international volunteers (coming from EU Member States, North Macedonia, and Turkey, Liechtenstein, Iceland and Norway, Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo, Montenegro, Serbia, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova, Ukraine, Algeria, Egypt, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Palestine, Syria, Tunisia, and the Russian Federation), 4 Italian volunteers and 2 volunteers outside the ESC countries project.

LUNAR09 "CRACK FEST" /// Rome /// FEST/MANU /// 19/06/2020-01/07/2020 /// VOLS: 10 /// AGE: 21+ /// Extra fee: 20€

SUMMARY: Different cultures and artistic worlds come together in this unique festival organized by the alternative community of the underground heart of Rome. Join forces with the local volunteers and immerse yourself in the world of comics and serigraphy!

PARTNER: It is 11 years that Lunaria supports Forte Prenestino with workcamps. Forte Prenestino is one of the most important alternative cultural and social centres in Italy (see www.forteprenestino.net). It was squatted 30 years ago and started hundreds of projects, campaigns, social actions. Today it's the most active promoter many cultural events, hosting an alternative community of artists, activists and social workers. By joining this workcamp you will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals: **SustainableCities&Communities-SDG11 SustainableConsumption&Production-SDG12.**

PROJECT: The “Crack International Comics Festival” is organized every year by Forte Prenestino Social Center, in Rome. Crack will involve editors and artists coming mainly from European and Mediterranean countries: 4 days of exhibitions, workshops and cultural exchange will involve hundreds of youngsters and experts. People from all sorts of backgrounds, coming together through their shared love for artworks and comics. Keep in mind that, due to the nature of the project, some organizational details may be subject to variation. The festival will be held from the 25th to the 28th of June 2020.

WORK: the volunteers will support the local group in managing the festival: preparation of the exhibits, restaurant work, tending to the pub and the tea room, cleaning of the area and other activities will be shared with the local volunteers. The work could be physically hard, but the environment is fun and easy going. Work shifts are usually 6-7 hours long at most.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD: Living conditions in the camp are basic. The volunteers will be sleeping in a dorm with 12 beds. Toilets will be shared and are could be in mint condition. Showers, will be located open-air (even with some privacy), so don't forget your swimsuit/trunks.

Volunteers will prepare their breakfast and will have lunch and dinner with the local volunteers, often cooking together.

LOCATION AND LEISURE: Forte Prenestino is located in Rome, in the Prenestino-Centocelle district. It is well connected to city centre with public transportation. Free time will be for intercultural and teambuilding activities, getting to know the community of Forte and some visit in Rome.

TERMINAL: Roma

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS: To be open minded and ready to live in an alternative community. This project requires a motivation letter and the signing of an agreement to confirm the understanding of the project. Expect a very very basic accommodation.

PROJECT: The project will take place in “Il Funambolo”, a service center for people with disabilities in Monterotondo, a town in the province of Rome. The idea for the workcamp stems from the need to rethink, remodel and recreate indoor and outdoor spaces of the center, based on the needs of the individuals who experience them daily. This is both a way to refurbish the center and to offer our guests opportunities for personal growth. The social aspect of the project focuses on the local community and the daily activities of the center's attendants, in which the volunteers will take part. It is important to keep the personal and common areas clean, to respect the guests' personal spaces and to observe silence in the guests' hours of rest.

WORK: The work of volunteers will consist of the renovation of the center's spaces, in all its phases: planning, the finding of the materials, etc. In the actual realization phase, the volunteers will be assisted by professional technicians from the staff. Part of the efforts will be focused on the “Spazio Aperto”, the largest hall in the center where many workshops and activities take place. Specific work will include the realization of a coat hanger and a polyfunctional wall with recyclable materials.

Volunteers will support the daily activities of the center's guests, accompany them in summer outings in the territory, as well as organize thematic evenings with other local realities. These activities will culminate in a great open-air party with the whole local community to promote active citizenship. Workdays will be 6 hours long, with 2 days a week for rest.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD: Accommodation will be in “Il Funambolo”, where volunteers will be arranged with their sleeping bags. Breakfast and lunch will be served in the dining hall, while dinners will be prepared together with the volunteers, to promote the collaboration among the group and the Cooperative staff. Vegetarian and vegan products are available.

LOCATION AND LEISURE TIME: In Monterotondo there are cinemas, libraries, museums, and pubs for young people and cultural Associations with special regard for local and traditional issues and with special attention to maintain and create a deep net of relationships in the community, making the area very attractive. The cooperative has promoted this net to support citizenry aggregation processes, to promote the organization of local activities managed by the Work Camp. **TERMINAL:** Fiumicino airport, **NEAREST TRAIN STATION:** Monterotondo. PARTNER: The workcamp is organized by Liberi Sogni a small no-profit organization that organizes, since 2006, social, cultural and environmental projects in the districts of Lecco, Bergamo and Monza e Brianza, in the region Lombardy. Liberi Sogni always considered the intercultural topic very important. Many people that work in the cooperative experimented directly with how important is to promote solidarity and attention towards cultures, especially among young people. By joining this workcamp you will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals: **LifeOnLand-SDG15** and **ClimateAction-SDG13**.

PROJECT: The cooperative is involved in promoting environmental protection, presenting alternative and sustainable ways of life through workshops in the schools, green days, weekends into nature and “Environmental Creative Camps” to preserve old woods and increase the value of our territory. Since 2014 Liberi Sogni is involved in a project called “Crazy-lienza, tornare alla natura per coltivare il futuro”, in English “Crazy-resilience, to go back to the nature to grow the future”. From this year a new environmental project has begun the “free university of the forest”, to be developed during the workcamp. Liberi Sogni organizes the camp “International Green Camp” to involve young people in the transformation of an abandoned wood in a place useful and pleasant for the local community and small local farms. The main aims of the project are environmental education and awareness through the active engagement of young people in an international and natural environment. Through the experience in the wood, we would like to achieve personal development, increase active citizenship in society, improving language competences, raise participants' awareness and understanding of other cultures and countries.

WORK: There will be two different work experiences: in the first, for four days, the children will live an experience of sharing with children and adults and the volunteers will have to take care of the arrangement of the camp and help the team in the kitchen and the activities; in the second, for seven days they will live an experience with young people with work to protect the forest and the environment.

The work will be mainly in the morning, about 4 hours per day with three types of activities:

- 1-Arrangement of the camp, taking care of the little vegetable garden and the water tank.
- 2- Work in the wood: building tables with wood materials (the tables will be used to create in the wood a relax-area for the local people) and fixing or building footpaths.
- 3- Cooking to prepare lunch with organic food coming from the nearby area

4- Support for the creation of artistic and environmental laboratories

In the afternoon the participants will take part in special workshops in local small farms, workshops with local associations for taking care of the paths and small rivers.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD: Accommodation and Food: The participants will sleep in tents of 4 people. The tents will be provided, but the volunteers will have to bring their camping mattress and sleeping bag. The tents will be divided into girls and boys tents. Participants must carry their belongings in a backpack, as they will arrive at camp on foot. Electricity and hot water will be provided by photovoltaic and solar panels. The toilet is 2 compost toilets, made of wood. The food will be prepared by the volunteers, who will eat together in a big tent. Most of the food will come from local farms from the fair trade. Drinking water will be taken from the local fountain. The food will be prepared by the participants, who will eat together in a big tent. Most of the food will come from local farms from the fair trade market. There won't be an internet connection and the use of electricity will be very few since we use photovoltaic panels. Participants can bring typical food of their countries to share but alcohol is not allowed in the camp.

LOCATION AND LEISURE: The project takes place in a wood located in a local park called "Parco del Monte di Brianza", in a place called "Campiano" which belongs to the municipality of Valgrestentino (LC), in the north of Italy. In the past, this area was used for agriculture, but now most of it is abandoned: we can see abandoned buildings, woods, and fields. Invasive plants are growing avoiding the growth of the local ones.

To reach the CRAZY-WOOD there's a gravel road or a footpath. (See the place in this map <https://goo.gl/maps/YxwVEVgUnPE2>) The closest village is Aizurro, a very little village with around 180 inhabitants. The closer place with facilities like shops, train station or other services is the village of Airuno. During the day there is some time for games and activities (for example tree-climbing, excursions, land art). Some evenings will be organized with "cultural nights", where one or more countries organize a dinner with the typical food and games and /or workshops to show their own culture. The rest of the evenings there will be moments at the fireplace, free evenings or some games in the darkness. **TERMINAL:** Milan

PARTNER: Montagna di Suono is a cultural association founded in 2008 which promotes music and arts in the Appennino Tosco-Emiliano area (the mountains between Florence and Bologna). We organize musical classes for kids and adults, concerts and the yearly antiracist Reno Splash festival, for knowledge and respect for the different cultures of the world. By joining this workshop you will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals: **Reduce inequality -SDG10**

PROJECT: The festival takes part in an expansive park in the town of Marzabotto (Bo) during four days of music, sport, culture and antiracism. In the morning there are lively discussions in Debate tents, in the afternoon sports tournaments and activities and in the evening/night a range of live concerts and DJ sets. The main genre is Reggae but various other genres are in the festival (ska, hip hop, indie, latin, dub). A temporary Camping is constructed and available for visitors who want to stay for the whole weekend.

WORK: Volunteers will help the festival staff with the organization, building-up, dismantlement and running of the festival area as well as promotion of the event in nearby communities. The main work activities during the camp will be the preparation of the Reno Splash festival. They can cook and there will also be a vegetarian menu and offer and delicious traditional Italian dishes such as tagliatelle, lasagna, pizza and spaghetti.

LOCATION AND LEISURE: Marzabotto is a little town in the Appennino mountains near Bologna (30km) and Florence (80km). It lies in the valley of the Reno river and it is full of green hills and valleys. It is famous for its resistance in WWII and was the site of a massacre of 770 inhabitants by the Nazi Army. The accommodation is located in the countryside but Bolognan thriving city life is near and easily accessible in your free time; or you could just chill out and visit some of the beautiful surrounding historical national parks. The weather will be warm but it can rain sometimes (we hope not). **TERMINAL:** Aeroporto G. Marconi di Bologna BLQ. Stazione FF.SS di Marzabotto (linea Bologna-Porretta)

PARTNER: Hermete was created in 1997 and mainly works in Valpolicella. It proposes to realize social and cultural projects for the community and for the territory, having quality and innovation as big targets. Hermete highly believes in network, this is why it operates at a local, national and European level with partners that seriously and passionately believe that education and culture are essential tools to the development and the growth of our society. One important project made by Hermete is CONTAMINA which takes place in the city of Brentino Belluno and Dolcè, a numerous activities are organized with the objective to challenge a teenage group (14-15 yo) on their entrepreneurship and their protagonism, a community of adults would then get involved with the new generations for their own sustainable future.

This project would like to give a professional path, logistical supports to informal groups in order to boost young participation and exchanges between adults and the new generations, all of it can take place with very concrete actions that could also develop local sustainability and culture. Then, international meetings (like workcamps) are organized with the purpose to develop mutual opportunities between all the participants. PARTNER: Association CSF-CooperazioneSenzaFrontiere (Giosef) is a youth network association based in Sicily engaged in intercultural initiatives that wants to be a space of aggregation and confrontation between young people so that they can give strength to their ideas and realize their own projects promoting youth inclusion and participation in all its forms and at all levels. The network collaborate with different realities in Sicily to develop new project and support the workcamps organization. This year they will work with UniverSicilia a cultural young association in the town of Sciacca known about the topic of rural life style. By joining this workcamp you will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals: **SustainableCommunities-SDG11**

PROJECT: The aim of this work is to show the international participants the ancient historical background of the town and to help our beauties to revive, in a green and artistic context. Thanks to the close contact with Italian art and culture, the participants will feel an unforgettable educational and enjoyable experience. One of our objectives is to deliver messages and draw the attention to the local population through pictures and photos made during the camp. Volunteers with artistic skills, such as singing, juggling, playing music are encouraged to apply for this camp as they will have the chance to help create a nice and friendly atmosphere. What you are going to do in these 15 days of activities is to get in touch with a new culture among a group of peers, trying to dig it (practically and metaphorically) in order to find the way of be protagonist of a new experience.

For Sicily's Roman rulers the town was, as well as a spa, an important hub for their efficient mail service, and for the Arabs it was a trading port with North African connections. Present-day Sciacca spreads over different levels of the hillside. Down by the sea is the big fishing harbour, along with a few houses and seafood restaurants. The town's main square, the panoramic Piazza Scandaliato, is on the next level up, with the heart of the historic centre spreading uphill behind it. Higher up the slope are the town's castle and the upper perimeter of the old city walls. Beyond the old settlement lie sprawling and unattractive modern areas. During the project the volunteers will visit the city of Sciacca and surroundings and its most significant and historical places. During the two free days we will make recreational visits: Agrigento Temples, Agrigento city center, seaside, sport activities in the sea. **TERMINAL:** Palermo Airport, Train or Bus Station: Agrigento

According to them, the bread produced on their farm is not their bread. It is the bread of the territory because everyone has been involved in the production. For that, they use sustainable practices in agriculture and organize events connected to them. You can have an overview of the activities organized by the center : www.tularu.it (in Italian). PROJECT: Through the work produced on the work-camp, the volunteers and the locals are going to prepare everything for the feast (a small festival organized around the farmers work). In 4 years they have created a local network and for the third time, in 2020 another farm in the territory, named Colle Berardino, will organize another harvest feast, in Rocca Sinibalda (30 km from Tularù). In order to raise a solidarity spirit, the volunteers in Tularù will help the friends in Rocca Sinibalda. In the same way, they will help during the harvest feast in Tularù. Volunteers will be involved in other activities with local associations in Cittaducale, like cleaning rural walks or others.

PROJECT: The project will take place in our "House" in Civita Castellana. This center includes many important structures and services for the individual: the family home "L'abbraccio di Arianna", the PAI (Individual Assistance Planning) house "Sergio Smargiassi", the apartment group "Casa 45 - dopo di noi" and the PAI daily service. PAI facilities are dedicated to the development and improvement of the autonomy skills of individuals with disabilities.

The physical portion of the planned work is to support with the maintenance of the facility, while the social aspect of the project focuses on the local community and the daily activities of the center's attendants, in which the volunteers will take part.

It is important to keep the personal and common areas clean, to respect the guests personal spaces and to observe silence in the guests' hours of rest.

WORK: The primary work of the volunteers will revolve around the maintenance and redecoration of the social garden and the service structures. In particular, the project foresees the adoption of a decorative flowerbed in a pedestrian square in the social district, as well as a new entrance for the daytime center. These tasks will be carried out side by side with the center's guests, who are people with a varying degree of disability.

Volunteers will aid in the daily activities of the House's guests, accompany them in summer outings in the territory, as well as organize thematic evenings with other local realities. These activities will culminate in a great open-air party with the whole local community to celebrate the cohesion with the associations and citizens of Civita.

Workdays will be 6 hours long, with 2/3 free days for resting.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD: The local host will make a guest house available for the volunteers' accommodation, on the premises of the facility, fitted with a kitchen to let the volunteers prepare their own meals for breakfast and lunch. Dinner will instead take place within the 3 family houses. Local and seasonal products are prioritized, and vegetables and fruit are available for vegetarian menus.

The guest house will have annexed services and showers, and a washing machine.

No beds are present, so volunteers are required to bring their own sleeping bag and inflatable mattress.

LOCATION AND LEISURE: Civita Castellana is a small town in the province of Viterbo (one hour from Rome), is a place rich in history and natural beauty. Located on the hydro-geographic basin of the Treja, famous for its forests and its historical and archaeological trails, dating back to the ancient street Amerina, is now the cradle of a biodistrict of agricultural production that

collects the territory of 10 municipalities of the area. The historic center, known for the Duomo Cosmatesco and Forte San Gallo dei Borgia, also hosts summer delegations of artists from all over the world to portray the breathtaking views of our countryside, inspired by centuries.

TERMINAL: Fiumicino Airport- Roma TRAIN STATION: Civita Castellana

Fiumicino airport is directly connected with Civita Castellana by train (2 hours).

REQUIREMENTS: Volunteers should be open-minded, responsible and supportive, especially considering they will be working closely with a disadvantaged community, that might require special care. Volunteers should bring their sleeping bag, inflatable mattress and work shoes.
